### Highlights

- As per UNOSAT satellite derived flood evolution assessment approximately 4.5 million people remain potentially exposed or living close to maximum floodwaters areas.
- Government has not reported any additional relief activities in KP, Punjab and Balochistan. Some relief activities in Sindh are still being carried out.
- Winter likely to make families more vulnerable especially women and children who are left in open spaces.





