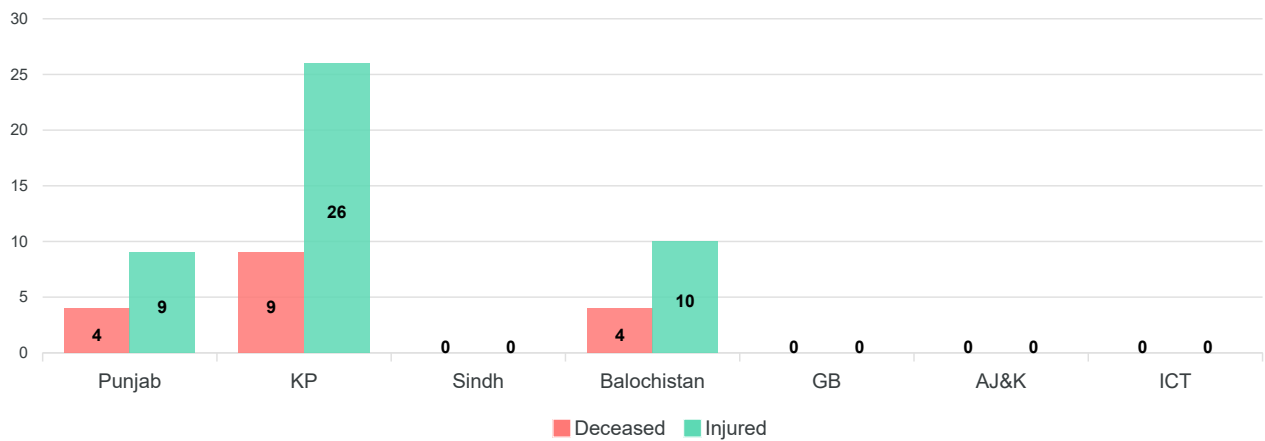

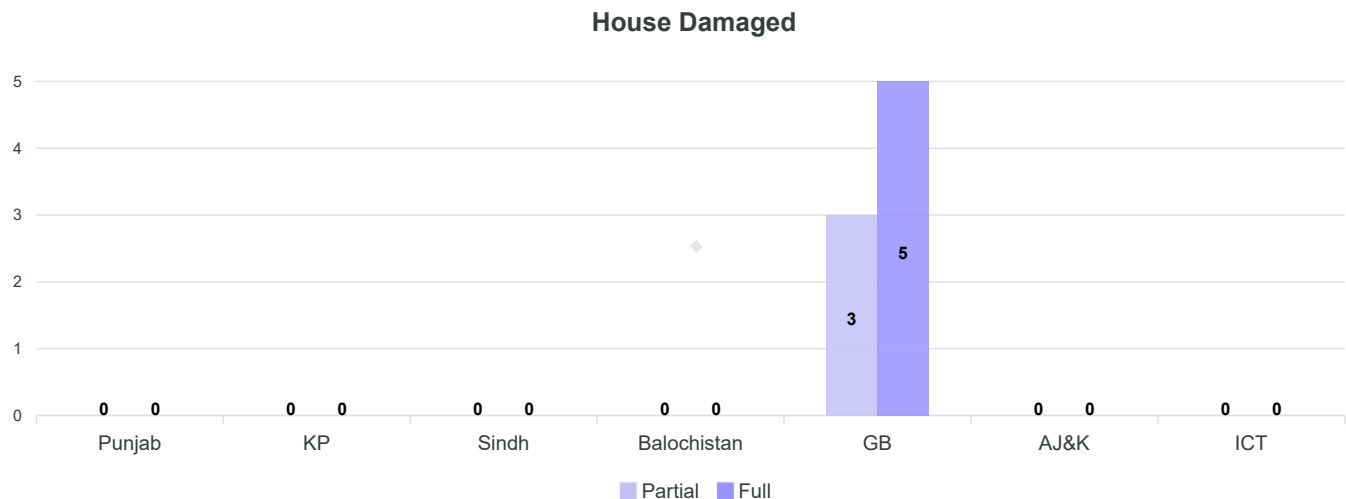

1. RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST AND OUTLOOK

- All the major rivers are flowing within their normal flows.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

- Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over the northern parts of country has moved eastwards.
- The seasonal low-pressure area lies over northwest Balochistan.
- Yesterday's Low-Pressure area over Northeast Odisha (India) with central pressure (996 hPa) has intensified into a well-marked Low with central pressure (992 hPa) and has moved westwards. It is expected to move over Jharkhand (India) within next 24 hours.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR 24-HOURS

- **Isolated rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected over the upper catchments of Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab rivers, **Kashmir**.
Punjab: Sialkot, Narowal, Kasur and Lahore.
- Mainly hot and humid weather is expected for rest of the country.
